Backup Player Policy (Updated – ISL 2025)

- Each game can have **backup players** based on the number of participating teams:
 - If a sport has **more than 1 team**, it can have **up to 2 backup players (maximum)**.
 - If a sport has **only 1 team**, it can have **only 1 backup player (maximum)**.
 - **Football and Cricket** are exceptions — **no backup players** are allowed.
 - A backup player may be used **only in the first round**, and **only if a main player is unavailable**.
 - Once a backup player is used, the **original player is disqualified** from that game for the rest of the tournament and **cannot be re-paired**.
 - Players who participate in the **first round must continue** in all subsequent rounds.
 - **No new or backup players** can be introduced after the **first round**.

Match Rescheduling Policy

- **No rescheduling** of matches will be allowed under normal circumstances.
 - Match timings may be adjusted by **a maximum of 1 hour** if a player is **present at the venue** and has **official work obligations**.
 - If a player remains **unavailable after 1 hour** in the first round, the **backup player cannot play**, and the **match will be forfeited**.

Discipline & Committee Decisions

- The **Sports Committee's decision** will be **final and binding** in all matters of disputes, gameplay issues, or disciplinary actions.
- Any **misbehavior, disrespect, or argument** with the **committee members, umpires, or officials** will result in a **penalty on the team's Fair Play Points** and may lead to

suspension from subsequent matches.

- Maintaining respect, integrity, and sportsmanship is **mandatory** for all participants.

Fair Play Points System

Each team starts with a **full Fair Play Score**. Points can be **deducted or rewarded** based on conduct, teamwork, and attitude.

Fair Play Criteria	Description	Points
 Respect to Officials	Teams that cooperate with umpires and organizers	1 or 0
 Sportsmanship	Helping opponents, accepting decisions gracefully	1 or 0
 Punctuality	Reporting on time for matches	1 or 0
 Minor Misconduct	Disputes or repeated warnings	1 or 0
 Serious Misconduct	Arguments, foul language, or disrespect toward officials	1 or 0
 Unsporting Behavior	Intentionally delaying games or unfair play	1 or 0
 Abusive or Aggressive Behavior	Towards players, officials, or spectators	1 or 0
 Disciplinary Action	As decided by Committee for repeated violations	1 or 0

Note:

- Fair Play Points contribute to the **team's overall league standing** in case of a tie.
 - The **Sports Committee** reserves the right to adjust Fair Play scoring in exceptional situations.

Auction Rules – ISL 2025

The **ISL Auction** is a strategic and exciting event where teams build their rosters while balancing budgets and talent.

1. Player Participation

- Every registered player will be part of the **auction pool**.
- Each player selected by a team must **participate in at least one sport** during the league.

2. Base Price

- The **base price** for every player is **₹10 Lakhs**.

3. Bidding Process

- Bidding will take place in **multiples of ₹5 Lakh and ₹10 Lakhs**.
- There is **no maximum limit** for bidding a player.
- Each team has a **total auction budget of ₹50 Crores**.
- Teams must manage their spending strategically to complete their roster within the allocated budget.

4. Time Limit

- Each player's bidding round will have a **maximum duration of 2 minutes**.
- If **no bid** is received within 30 sec in the time limit, the player will be declared **unsold**.

5. Team Composition

- **Auction pool:** 121 players
- **Teams:** 4
- **Target purchases (auctioned):** 30, 30, 30, 31 → **total 121**
- **Female players registered:** 13 → target distribution **3 + 3 + 3 + 4** (final)

- **Captains & Owners: not** part of auction (added extra to team totals)
- **All female players will be auctioned first**, before male players.
 - Purpose: ensure teams can meet the minimum female quota while bidding dynamics are simple and transparent.
- During the female phase, teams may bid subject to the same per-team auction cap. Maintain a **running female count** per team visible to organisers.
- In case of any unsold player **committee** will decide and allocate randomly to any team to maintain the team balance.



6. Auction Conduct

- The **auction will be conducted by the Host** of the InfoBeans Sports League 2025.
 - The **Host's decision** during bidding or any dispute will be **final and binding**.
